6. Regularly publishing information on our environmental performance through our commitments to initiatives such as Planet Mark, Considerate Constructors Scheme and the Sustainable Development Goals.
7. Ongoing and structured training of our staff, clients, supply chain and sub-contractors with the aim of enhancing their awareness of relevant environmental issues and securing their effective participation in helping to minimise our environmental impact
8. Reducing the environmental impact of our final constructed product through improved design, planning, specification and operational management
9. Commitment to efficient use of energy, water resources and materials, including the use of defined measures/processes to minimise waste and re-use and recycle wherever possible
